The student must have a diagnosed and documented impairment specified from one of the two sections below: (Must be diagnosed and documented by a Physician, Physician's Assistant, and/or Advanced Practice Nurse.) _____Neuromuscular _____Postural/Skeletal _____Traumatic 1. _____Neurological Impairment Growth Which: ____affects Motor Function ____ modifies Gait Patterns (Optional) _____ Requires the use of prosthesis or mobility device, including but not limited to canes, crutches, walker or wheelchair. 2. Cardio/Respiratory Impairment that is deemed safe for competitive athletics but limits the intensity and duration of physical exertion such that sustained activity for over five minutes at 60% of maximum heart rate for age results in physical distress in spite of appropriate management of the health condition. (NOTE:) A condition that can be appropriately managed with appropriate medications that eliminate physical or health endurance limitations WILL NOT be considered eligible for adapted athletics. Specific exclusions to PI competition: The following health conditions, without coexisting physical impairments as outlined above, do not qualify the student to participate in the PI Division even though some of the conditions below may be considered Health Impairments by an individual's physician, a student's school, or government agency.
